Young Aviator Badge Level 1 (Primary)

To gain this badge,



Cub Scouts must complete the following:

1. Know 5 occupations associated with an airport
2. Visit an airport and share with your leader on your experience
3. Choose two of the following:
 - a. Make and fly three different types of paper aeroplane
 - b. Identify six airlines from their markings.
 - c. Collect and identify six different pictures of aircraft and share them with other Cub Scouts.

Young Aviator Badge Level 2 (Primary)

To gain this badge,



Cub Scouts must complete the following:

1. Hold the Young Aviator Level 1 Badge
2. Lead a six on a visit to an airfield, air display or air museum and do a presentation to the rest of the six after the visit highlighting experiences and exhibits saw and lesson learnt.
3. Choose three of the following:
 - a. Make and fly a kite
 - b. Identify four different types of military and civilian aircraft
 - c. Name and identify the main parts of an aeroplane.
 - d. Assemble a plastic scale model aeroplane to a reasonable standard.
 - e. Explain how different weather conditions can affect air activities.
