

"Well Done, Lavan", said the Chief Commissioner.





My name is Lavan Ajai S/O Kumaran. I am a Secondary 3 Scout from Tanjong Katong Seladang Scout Group and a recipient of the Chief Commissioner's Well-Done Badge for Q4 2022.

On 18 Feb 2023, I met the Chief Commissioner, Mr Desmond Chong, for tea at The Singapore Scout Association headquarters at 1 Bishan St 12, with other Scouts and one of my teachers in charge, Ms Lily Toh. I had the opportunity to share how much I had learnt from Scout activities. These include leadership skills and strong values through Scout activities such as camping, outdoor cooking, and pioneering.

Mr Chong praised me for what I had done for a member of the elderly during Job Week in 2022. While fundraising, I chanced on a house where a senior citizen lived. She was not feeling well, but refused to call for an ambulance or leave her house. I took the initiative to help contact her family, and waited outside her flat for them to arrive to care for her. Based on that experience, I joined the Lions Befrienders Club and began volunteering with the "I-Ok@LB" programme, which provides needy seniors with a digital tablet to monitor their own well-being, receive customised health alerts, and stay in touch with their family members. During the school holidays, I now engage senior citizens in both English and my mother tongue, Tamil, and share how to operate these tablets.

I guess these elderly folk had contributed to Singapore in their own way when they were younger, even if they had since fallen on hard times. As teenagers, we can do a little more in our free time to make sure these seniors feel that society still cares for them. I would encourage my fellow Scouts to look out for ways in which we can help others around us.

Scouting is a way of life. Lately, I had a chat with Uncle William, one of the school attendants, on mobile phone use. It was a good conversation and part of inter-generational dialogue. We should always be on the lookout on how to make life better for others even outside of activity time.
